IGCSE General summary



The overall June 2022 pass rate is slightly lower than June 2021; however there is consistency in similar subjects receiving pass rates higher than world average (English First Language, English as Additional Language, Mathematics International, Coordinated Sciences, and Music).

There is evidence of strong teaching and learning, with 9 out of 16 subjects receiving pass rate higher than world averages.

Assuming June 2022 results are reliable indicators of general performance, they show improvements in subjects that previously had results less than the 2021 world average. (ie. History, Geography, French).

Introduction of Physical Education resulted in positive results, consider challenge of completing this course under Covid Pandemic condition.




Summary of May 2022 IBDP results

30 candidates

- ★ 29 full IBDP candidates, 1 courses candidates (indiv. subjects)
 - 27 Diplomas Obtained
- ★ 93% of students in the year group obtained an IBDP

VIS's May 2022 cohort size was 31 (29 Full IBDP candidate, 1 IBDP courses candidate, 1 student did not qualify for either)

- Highest points awarded = 42
- Average obtained by candidates who received the Diploma = 34 pts
 - May 2021: 33 pts
- Average obtained by all diploma candidates = 33 pts
 - May 2021: 33 pts
- World Average Diploma Total = 33 pts
 - May 2021: 33 pts
- Average grade obtained by candidates
 who received the Diploma = 5.35
 - May 2021: 5.2

IBDP General summary

Similar to the June 2022 IGCSE cohort, the May 2022 cohort of IBDP candidates completed the program and their examinations under uniquely challenging circumstances of the Covid 19 pandemic. Their teaching and learning were interrupted in Year 1 and Year 2 with Distance Learning Mode.

Self Taught Literature courses performed better this year, with more courses performing better than World Average for May 2022 series.

Extended Essay results improved in May 2022 series, compared to May 2021 series. EE Coordinator improved efforts to support Supervisors and candidates in process.

Room for improvement remains for TOK, however VIS candidates continue scoring at/around world average.

Moving Forward in the IGCSE & IBDP

The IB Middle Years Programme will move into High School in September 2023, soon replacing the two-year IGCSE Programme. Current Grade 8 cohort will move into MYP in Grade 9 (September 2023). Current Grade 9 cohort will be last IGCSE cohort, sitting exams in June 2024. IGCSE external exams will be replaced by MYP eAssessment

Curriculum alignment remains a focus, ensuring consistency in knowledge, skills, and understanding from Grade 9 through to Grade 12.

Student result data is being used by High School leadership to support teachers in reflecting on/improving teaching and learning practices.

Incorporation of Grade 9 Collaborative Community Service Project and Grade 10 Personal Project in the IGCSE Program provides sound foundation for students entering the IB Careers Related and IB Diploma Programmes
